

Quality Policy and Objectives

The South African Institute for Drug-Free Sport's focus is determined by Act No. 33 of 2024: The South African Institute for Drug-Free Sport Amendment Act 2024.

To promote the participation in sport free from the use of prohibited substances or methods intended to artificially enhance performance, thereby rendering impermissible doping practices, which are contrary to the principles of fair play and medical ethics, in the interest of the health and well-being of sportspersons; and to provide for matters connected therewith.

We will deliver anti-doping services that comply with the applicable International Standards, Technical Documents and Guidelines of the World Anti-Doping Code to protect clean athletes by promoting clean sport and thereby ensuring that health, fairness and equality for athletes exists in South African sport.

We will control our activities through the application, maintenance and continual improvement of a Quality Management System (QMS) complying with the requirements of ISO 9001:2015. All personnel are required to support this policy and to work in accordance with the Organisation's documented procedures.


Our Objectives

- Create and foster an operational environment that is conducive to the continuous improvement of our processes through ongoing training, monitoring of trends and the education of our personnel.
- Regularly communicate with all interested parties to ensure that they understand that we are committed to exceeding the requirements of our QMS.
- Maintain, develop and improve our QMS to align with South Africa's obligations to the UNESCO International Convention Against Doping in Sport and any applicable SAIDS rules, national legislation and the World Anti-Doping Code.
- Ensure the health, hygiene, safety and security of our personnel, whilst they are performing their tasks and activities (the affected parties include SAIDS full and part-time staff viz, Sample Collection Personnel, Educators and any other SAIDS staff).

This policy provides a framework for establishing quality objectives and both this policy and the Organisation's objectives will be reviewed annually, to ensure their currency and suitability.
